One of the other directors brought the BMW 507, the stunning roadster from the 1950's. The car features a 4.9 litre V8 from the BMW M5 which is producing near 400bhp and will propel the Z8 from 0-60 in 4.5 seconds. The car comes with a 6 speed manual gearbox, a limited slip differential, 50/50 weight distribution due to the engine sitting behind the front wheels.
