Description

Few cars define an era quite like the Jaguar E-Type. Enzo Ferrari famously called it “the most beautiful car ever made”, and over half a century later, its timeless design, elegant engineering, and unmistakable charm continue to captivate collectors and enthusiasts across the world. This stunning Series 1.5 Roadster, manufactured in July 1968, is one of the last of just 319 original right-hand-drive 4.2-litre examples ever produced by Jaguar Cars — making it a highly sought-after and significant model in the E-Type lineage. Combining the purity of the early Series 1 with the mechanical refinements that paved the way for the Series 2, it represents the best of both worlds. Finished in Carmen Red with a Black leather interior, this matching-numbers car is accompanied by an extensive and beautifully documented history file, confirming its originality and long, well-preserved life. **HISTORY & PROVENANCE:** This E-Type was originally supplied as a UK right-hand-drive car and retains its matching-numbers 4.2-litre XK engine, verified by its Jaguar Heritage Trust Certificate. In 2017 it underwent a comprehensive refurbishment completed in the summer of 2018. A full photographic record of the works is included within the accompanying history file. The car’s provenance is exceptional, featuring a large archive of invoices and records dating back to 1969, including its original green logbook, early maintenance bills, and delightful period documentation. One charming highlight is an invoice from 1973 — a 27,000-mile service costing just 34 shillings and 23 pence, a small but evocative piece of this car’s story.
